First Year Incoming Student

\$95,000

Includes 12 months:

- Bridge-to-College Orientation (starts early July)
- Fall Term
- Spring Term
- Core Term (mid-May through June 30)

Payment Plans

- Annual (3% discount): \$92,150 due April 1
- Four payments: \$23,750 due April 1, July 1, October 1, December 1
- Twelve payments (+2% plan fee): \$8,075 due on the 1st from April to March

Please Note: \$5,500 is due upon acceptance of the enrollment offer. \$2,500 of that amount is a one-time Enrollment Fee, which confirms a student's space, is separate, non-refundable, and is not applied to any tuition amounts listed here. The remaining \$3,000 will be applied as a credit to the first tuition invoice due as per the selected payment plan.

Returning Residential Students for the 26/27 Year

Includes 12 months:

- Summer Term (early July through late August)
- Fall Term
- Spring Term
- Core Term (mid-May through June 30)
- Enrollment Decision due by March 1, 2026

Payment Plans

- Annual (3% discount): \$87,785 due April 1
- Four payments: \$22,625 due April 1, July 1, October 1, December 1
- Twelve payments (+2% plan fee): \$7692.50 due on the 1st from April to March

First and Second Year Connections, Non-Residential

\$47,500

Includes 12 months:

- July 1 through June 30
- College enrollment required
- Enrollment Decision due by April 1, 2026

Payment Plans

- Annual (3% discount): \$46,075 due May 1
- Four payments: \$11,875 due May 1, July 1, October 1, December 1
- Eight payments (+2% plan fee): \$6,056.25 due on the 1st from May to December

We have created this all-inclusive annual fee for Connections in recognition that students are transitioning to greater independence in all aspects of their lives and benefit from coaching and case management throughout the year. During the summer of transition from Residential to Connections, a student may start a new apartment lease in the community anytime over the summer. Pricing of the Connections or Residential program will not be adjusted to charge more or less based on the move-out date. However, beds in our dorms past July 1 while waiting to move out are only available on a space available basis. If a student chooses to remain home or travel out of state during the enrollment period, services will be provided remotely and there will be no adjustment to the rate.

Third and Subsequent Years of Connections, Non-Residential

Customized

Students may elect to enroll in one, two or all three of the programs listed below.

Pricing for each program includes 12 months:

- July 1 through June 30
- College enrollment required
- Six-month enrollment available pro-rated to 50% if student is graduating after fall term
- If a student chooses to travel during the enrollment period, services will be provided remotely
- Enrollment Decision due by April 1, 2026

1) Giving & Engaging Program

\$12,000

Students who are still in college may maintain access to Mansfield Hall, are welcome to up to 3 meals per week, and are encouraged to participate in social & Giving activities both at Mansfield Hall and in the community. Integration into Mansfield Hall's social coaching continues uninterrupted, as do family updates and access to the on-call support network.

Payment Plans

- Annual (3% discount): \$11,640 due May 1
- Four payments: \$3,000 due May 1, July 1, October 1, December 1
- Eight payments (+2% plan fee): \$1,530 due on the 1st from May to December

2) Living Program

\$14,000

Individualized community-based independent living support, including coordinated case management, inapartment checks bi-weekly, ongoing family updates, continued access to on-call support, etc.

Payment Plans

- Annual (3% discount): \$13,580 due May 1
- Four payments: \$3,500 due May 1, July 1, October 1, December 1
- Eight payments (+2% plan fee): \$1,785 due on the 1st from May to December

3) Learning Program – In Person OR Online

3a) In Person Academic Coaching

\$19,000

Includes one-on-one academic coaching as well as access to The Hall for Structured Study Time, writing support, group-based academic coaching, and ongoing academic updates to the family.

Payment Plans

- Annual (3% discount): \$18,430 due May 1
- Four payments: \$4,750 due May 1, July 1, October 1, December 1
- Eight payments (+2% plan fee): \$2,422.50 due on the 1st from May to December

3b) Online Academic Coaching

Canopy College Coaching, our remote coaching platform, is offered to our third + year Connections students with the enrollment fee waived.

- Packages offer up to 1, 2, or 3 hours/wk of 1-1 online academic coaching, as well as drop-in office hours
- Canopy's services are academic term-based if support is needed outside of academic terms it will be at a pro-rated rate

For example, we may recommend that a Third Year Connections student utilizes Giving & Engaging (\$12,000) and the In-Person Academic Support Plan (\$19,000) for a total of \$31,000 in annual services. In this scenario, in-person Living support, including in-person apartment checks, etc., is no longer included in their services.

Another example may be that a student chooses the Living (\$14,000) and Giving & Engaging (\$12,000) and one hour per week of Canopy College Coaching (\$6,900). Total tuition for this combination would be \$32,900. In this scenario, the student is no longer utilizing in-person academic support. Instead, they are relying on the remote coaching services from Canopy College Coaching.

The Hall Society

Community & Support for Students No Longer Attending College

Services are available from The Hall Society after the student has successfully completed one year of our Residential program and is no longer pursuing an academic track.

The Hall Society provides Members access to a curated, supported, and facilitated social community, complete with events and activities with other members of The Hall Society. This includes access to a standing weekly social event, as well as an average of two weekend events per month (cost of all activities is included in program fees). The Hall Society also provides individualized case management, including in-person life coaching meetings focused on goal setting, job readiness, social development, and coordinated case management.

Includes 12 months: \$25,000

- July 1 through June 30
- If a student is traveling during the year, services will be provided remotely
- Enrollment Decision due by April 1, 2026
- Six-month enrollment period available, pro-rated to \$12,500

Payment Plans

- Annual (3% discount): \$24,250 due May 1
- Four payments: \$6,250 due May 1, July 1, October 1, December 1
- Eight payments (+2% plan fee): \$3,187.50 due on the 1st from May to December

OPTIONAL ADD-ON: Independent Living Support

Students enrolled in The Hall Society may also add on individualized community-based independent living support.

Student must be living within 10 miles of Mansfield Hall

\$14,000

- Includes bi-weekly (twice per month) in-apartment support
- July 1 through June 30
- If a student is traveling during the year, services will be provided remotely

For a total of \$39,000/yr

• Six-month enrollment period available, pro-rated to \$7,000

Payment Plans (prices are in addition to the Hall Society fees listed above)

- Annual (3% discount): \$13,580 due May 1
- Four payments: \$3,500 due May 1, July 1, October 1, December 1
- Eight payments (+2% plan fee): \$1,785 due on the 1st from May to December

Please Note: Membership in The Hall Society does not include open/unstructured access to the residence at Mansfield Hall or access to Mansfield Hall's on-call support network.

All Incoming/New students are expected to attend both Bridge-to-College Orientation & Core Term. Exceptions are handled on an individualized basis, with prior approval from Mansfield Hall. All returning students are enrolled in Summer and Core term by default but may opt out by giving notice.
